

CHAPTER 6, SECTION 2 CONSRUCTION/MODIFICATION PERMIT HEARING - The State of Wyoming, Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Air Quality, proposes to approve a request by Powder River Basin Industrial Complex, LLC to modify the Converse County Transloading Facility by authorizing the transloading of 26,760 tons per year of barite (FUG002) and one (1) 115 hp John Deere 4045TF150A diesel generator engine (ENG006). The Converse County Transloading Facility is located at 450 Irvine Road, Douglas, in Converse County, Wyoming

Pursuant to the provisions of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act and the Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations, a public hearing relative to the requested issuance of an air quality permit for the proposed construction will be held in person at 1:00 pm, Monday, June 2, 2025, in the Converse County Library (Meeting Room 1), located at 300 E. Walnut Street, Douglas, in Converse County, Wyoming.

The hearing will be conducted pursuant to the provisions of Chapter IX, Section 5 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure adopted by the Environmental Quality Council, and therefore, will not be conducted as a contested case. The purpose of the hearing is to gather information concerning the emissions of air pollutants into the atmosphere and the impact of such pollutants on the ambient air quality. The scope of the hearing will be limited to such issues in order for the Department of Environmental Quality to determine whether or not the applicable Air Quality Standards and Regulations will be violated as a result of the construction of the facility.
