

2026 PRIMARY ELECTION PROCLAMATION CONVERSE COUNTY, WYOMING

I, Karen Rimmer, the duly elected County Clerk in and for the County of Converse, State of Wyoming, do hereby state in accordance with Wyoming Statute §22-2-109, that:

1. Public notice is hereby given that a **Primary Election will be held on TUESDAY, AUGUST 18, 2026**, for the purpose of nominating the offices listed in this proclamation and for electing Precinct Committeemen and Precinct Committeewomen.
2. Public notice is also hereby given that a **General Election will be held on TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026**, for the purpose of electing all offices listed in this proclamation except for Precinct Committeemen and Precinct Committeewomen.
3. The filing dates for State, County, and Municipal offices for the Primary Election are **May 14 through May 29, 2026**, at the filing locations listed below.
4. The filing dates for School Board Trustees and Special Districts for the General Election are **August 5 through August 24, 2026**, at the filing locations listed below.
5. Voters are **prohibited** from changing political party affiliation from **May 14 through August 18, 2026**, or the first day of candidate filing through Primary Election Day.
6. The last day to register to vote with the County Clerk or the Town/City Clerks of Converse County is **August 3, 2026** for the Primary Election and **October 19, 2026** for the General Election. After these dates, voters who register must immediately vote absentee in the Clerk's Office or register and vote at the polls on Election Day.

VOTER ASSISTANCE: Pursuant to W.S. §22-13-113(a), any elector who requires assistance to vote because of blindness, disability, or inability to read or write, may be given assistance by a person of the elector's choice, other than the elector's employer or an agent of that employer or an officer or agent of the elector's union. There will be an accessible ballot marking device (Express Vote) available at every polling place. If you have any questions regarding the accessibility

of your polling place, please contact the County Clerk's Office at (307) 358-2244.

VOTER AND VOTER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- As of July 1, 2025, anyone registering to vote must provide proof of identification, proof of US citizenship, and proof of Wyoming residency for a minimum of thirty (30) days. Information pertaining to acceptable documentation can be found on the Wyoming Secretary of State website: <https://sos.wyo.gov/Elections/State/RegisteringToVote.aspx>
- Every voter requesting an absentee ballot in person at the County Clerk's Office must present acceptable identification before receiving their ballot.
- Every voter who votes in person at the polls must present acceptable identification prior to receiving a ballot.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Absentee ballots may be requested at any time during the election year: 1.) in person at the Converse County Courthouse, County Clerk Office, 107 N. 5th Street, Suite 114, Douglas, Wyoming, 82633; 2.) in writing at the aforementioned address or by emailing clerk@conversecountywy.gov, or 3.) by calling 307-358-2244. If requesting an absentee ballot in writing, please include full legal name, physical address and mailing address where ballot is to be mailed, date of birth, party affiliation, and phone number. Absentee ballots will be available 28 days prior to each election except for ballots issued under the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA), which will be available 45 days prior to each election for UOCAVA-qualified electors only.

CAMPAIGN REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Pursuant to W.S. 22-25-106, all candidates except for Precinct Committeemen/Women and Special District Trustees, whether successful or not, shall file an itemized statement of contributions and expenditures at least 7 days but not more than 14 days before any primary, general or special election. Any contribution received or expenditure made after the statement has been filed, through the day of the election, whether a primary, general or special election, shall be filed as an amendment to the statement within 10 days after the election. These reports are required even if no funds were expended or received. Candidates for county, municipal, and school district offices must file their reports with the County Clerk. Candidates for federal and state offices must file their reports with the Secretary of State. Any candidate who fails to file completed itemized statement within the time required, or exceeds the maximum allowable expenditures, is in violation of the Election Code and may be subject to civil penalties including fines of up to \$200 per day. Any candidate in violation of this section shall not receive a certificate of election or nomination; shall not be allowed to fulfill their elected office; and a vacancy shall be declared.

OTHER CRITICAL ELECTION DATES

- **August 17, 2026:** Deadline for Minor and Provisional Candidate Filing to Secretary of State for Federal and State candidates and to the County Clerk for County offices.
- **August 24, 2026:** Deadline for Independent Candidate Filing to Secretary of State for Federal and State candidates and to the County Clerk for County offices.
